

ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS:

Taxes and Utility Bills may be paid electronically through your online banking website. The payments would be under Town of Balgonie Taxes and Town of Balgonie Utilities.

(Do not choose Balgonie Water—this payee is a previous business and is not connected with the Town of Balgonie.)

Please contact the Town office to obtain your account numbers.

Electronic payments for Utilities and Taxes are a convenient way to pay your bills, but they are not instantaneous. Please allow 2-3 business days before any due date so that your payment is receipted by our office before any penalties apply. The bank requires time to process the payment and advise the Town. The receipts for electronic payments will be available for pickup or mailed or emailed upon request.

Tree branch and grass pickup was discontinued in the Town of Balgonie in 2013. Town Council has authorized "Senior Residents" to pre-register and pay a fee to obtain this service from the Town fee.

All residents are welcome to take their grass clippings and tree branches to the Town Transfer station.

Reminder:

Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 24 hours except weekends and holidays. If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park on your own property. All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair. Storage of unlicensed and junked vehicles on your property are considered to be a "nuisance" by Town of Balgonie Bylaws.




Balgonie Elks Lodge #572 Information



In an emergency who do we call....

911 of course!

When a person places a 911 call, the dispatcher will alert the ambulance to your location. And while the ambulance is on their way, the First Responders who live in your community, are also dispatched to you.

In big cities, emergency crews can get to the scene in a matter of minutes – a luxury that rural communities do not have. These areas – such as ours- rely on a different group of people to provide help while waiting for the ambulance to arrive. First Responders are volunteers who can mean the difference between life and death.

First Responders are trained volunteers in your community, who are on call all day, everyday, to respond to medical and trauma emergencies in your community. They provide lifesaving medical services to you while waiting for the ambulance to arrive. It is not simply a matter of volunteering. First, a rigorous set of courses are required – CPR, assessments, oxygen therapy, spinal immobilization and special trauma courses. A critical part of the training is the assessment. When first arriving on the scene, the First Responder must assess the situation and make appropriate decisions.

So who are the First Responders? They are a group of dedicated, reliable, licensed volunteers that have taken the responsibility to provide you with care until the ambulance arrives. First Responders can make a huge difference in an emergency situation by providing life saving skills (CPR, controlling bleeding, providing oxygen, treating anaphylaxis, delivering babies, comforting patients and their families as well as many other medical and trauma emergencies). First responders are paramount in ensuring help is nearby.


