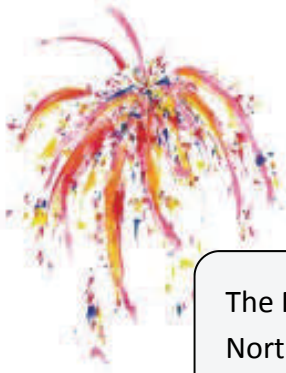

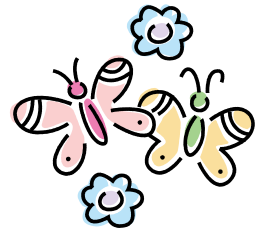

ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS:

Taxes and Utility Bills may be paid electronically through your online banking website. The payments would be under Town of Balgonie Taxes and Town of Balgonie Utilities.

(Do not choose Balgonie Water—this payee is a previous business and is not connected with the Town of Balgonie.)

Please contact the Town office to obtain your account numbers.

Electronic payments for Utilities and Taxes are a convenient way to pay your bills, but they are not instantaneous. Please allow 2-3 business days before any due date so that your payment is received by our office before any penalties apply. The bank requires time to process the payment and advise the Town. The receipts for electronic payments will be available for pickup or mailed or emailed upon request.

Tax Notices have now been mailed for 2014. Payments made prior to August 31/14 will have a 5% discount on the current municipal portion only. Any tax payments are first applied to arrears owing. Please allow 3 business days for electronic or mailed payments.

Utility bills will be mailed out in July for the July to September billing period.

PAYMENTS ACCEPTED AT THE OFFICE BY CASH, CHEQUE, BANK DRAFT OR DEBIT. WE DO NOT ACCEPT CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS. If you are paying your taxes by DEBIT ensure that your daily limit on your card is sufficient with your financial institution.

Reminder:

Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 24 hours except weekends and holidays. If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park on your own property. All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair. Storage of unlicensed and junked vehicles on your property are considered to be a "nuisance" by Town of Balgonie Bylaws.

BE A RESPONSIBLE PET OWNER:

 - Spay or neuter your pet.



A CAT TRAP—is available to residents of Balgonie. If you wish to obtain the cat trap, a \$20.00 deposit and permit are available at the Town Office.

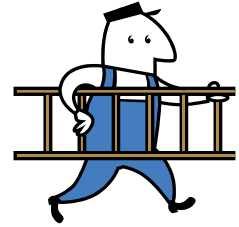
Pets at large may be impounded and turned over to the Regina Humane Society.

Permits

The Town of Balgonie requires building permits for anyone building houses, accessory buildings, renovations and decks. Please ensure that you have completed the paperwork with the Town before starting construction.

Permits are also required if you will be moving a structure or demolishing a structure on your property.

Applications can be obtained at the Town Office and permits will be issued once they have been reviewed and approved by the Town and the Building Inspector. Please speak to staff at the Town Office to ensure that you have the information BEFORE moving, demolishing or constructing. The planned construction needs to comply with our Zoning Bylaw and be authorized for development. Please ensure that you have submitted these forms in advance of your project. There may be 2- 3 weeks after submission until a decision has been reached regarding your application.

Water Softeners:

Balgonie is currently receiving water from Pilot Butte through the new water transmission line. As you may have noticed, the water is quite soft compared to the previous Town water source.

Some residents have inquired about whether or not a water softener is necessary. Each household will have to decide this for themselves based on their personal preference.

However, keep in mind that if at some time, our water supply changes, residents may again, want to have the ability to soften the water at their discretion.

Below is an environmental analysis report of the water we are receiving currently. You may want to discuss this issue with your water softening company to determine an adequate setting to soften your household water.

If there are future changes in the chemistry of the water which Balgonie is distributing through the water distribution system, residential, water softening systems may, again, have to be adjusted.

Flood Maintenance and Prevention-

Maintaining Home Drainage System

Regular maintenance of your home drainage system can often be the difference between staying dry or being flooded. Once a year, it's a good idea to evaluate the condition of your system – inside and out. If you find a problem, make fixing it a priority.

Remember: Most flooding on private property is caused by the failure of one or more home drainage elements.

The following provides a maintenance checklist you should review each year. If you are unsure of what to do, call a professional.

Outside

Eavestroughs & Downspouts

- Clean leaves and debris from inside the trough and downspouts.
- Tighten elbows and other connections.
- Caulk and seal any leaks.
- Repair or replace sagging, badly dented or cracked sections.

Splash Pads & Extensions

- Reconnect any loose pads or extensions.
- Replace badly dented extensions.
- Check soft plastic, roll out extensions for leaks and to determine if they work properly.

Lot Grading

- Check the slope from the basement wall.
- Check for settling, particularly under stairs and decks.
- Raise any low spots.
- Look for cracks or spaces on driveways, sidewalks and patios that are next to the foundation wall. Caulk or waterproof where needed.



Inside

Foundation Walls

- Check for moisture along the walls and the floor.
- Fill and seal any visible cracks.

Sump Pump

- Check for power.
- Test the pump by pouring water into the pump well.
- Check the outside pipe to confirm water is flowing towards the street or back lane.
- Check and repair any leaks in the sump pump pipe.
- Disconnect sump pump discharge hose in winter conditions to avoid freezing in the line.

Sewer backup:

- Sewer caps should be on to prevent sewer backup.
- Install a backflow prevention valve

Plumbing Fixtures

- Maintain proper water levels in traps in floor drains and toilets to minimize odours.

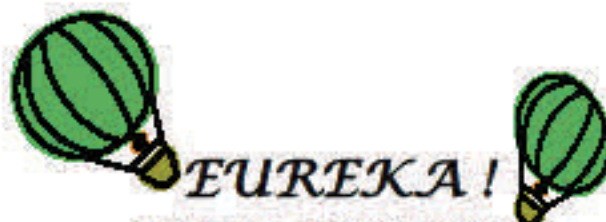

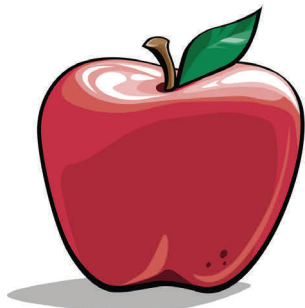
