TOWN COUNCIL MEETINGS are open to the public. They are regularly scheduled on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of every month starting at 6:15 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Balgonie Administration Building.




Vehicle Washing

ATV'S AND DIRTBIKES WITHIN TOWN LIMITS

This is the annual spring reminder for any residents with ATVs/Quads, Dirt Bikes, Pocket Bikes or any other unlicensed vehicles that they are not to be driven on the streets, back alleys, walking paths, CP area north of Railway Street or the east side of town by the overpass.

Reminder:

Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 24 hours except weekends and holidays. If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park on your own property. All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair. Storage of unlicensed and junked vehicles on your property are considered to be a "nuisance" by Town of Balgonie Bylaws.

Please do not park trailers on the street—This causes difficulties for other drivers, blocks site lines and can be dangerous for pedestrians and cyclists.
