ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS:

Taxes and utility bills may be paid electronically through your online banking website. The payments would be under Town of Balgonie Taxes and Town of Balgonie Utilities.

(Do not choose Balgonie Water—this payee is a previous business and is not connected with the Town of Balgonie.)

Please contact the Town office to obtain your account numbers.

Electronic payments for utilities and taxes are a convenient way to pay your bills, but they are not instantaneous. Please allow 2-3 business days before any due date so that your payment is receipted by our office before any penalties apply. The bank requires time to process the payment and advise the Town.

The receipts for electronic payments will be available for pickup or mailed or emailed upon request.

TOWN COUNCIL MEETINGS are open to the public. They are regularly scheduled on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of every month starting at 6:15 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Balgonie Administration Building.

Council meetings in OCTOBER are scheduled for OCTOBER 6 and 27, 2014.

Water & Sewer Bylaws:

The Town Council of Balgonie is currently reviewing Water and Sewer Rates and Water and Sewer Management bylaws. The water transmission line from Pilot Butte is now complete and operational. Although the Town received a grant, Balgonie will be repaying on a debenture to cover its portion of the project. Town Council will be considering this expense, as well as, future lagoon expansion during this process.

Reminder to Balgonie Residents:

Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 24 hours except weekends and holidays. If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park on your own property. All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair. Storage of unlicensed and junked vehicles on your property are considered to be a "nuisance" by Town of Balgonie Bylaws.

Please do not park trailers on the street—This causes difficulties for other drivers, blocks site lines and can be dangerous for pedestrians and cyclists.



NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

Pursuant to *The Municipalities Act*, public notice is hereby given that the Town of Balgonie intends to restructure by adding the following lands from the Rural Municipality of Edenwold No. 158.

The lands to be added to the Town of Balgonie are portions of the South West Quarter Section 4, Township 18, Range 17; Section 33, Township 17, Range 17 and North West Quarter Section 34, Township 17, Range 17 all West of the Second Meridian as shown on the sketch below.



The reasons for the proposal are:

- Provide additional land in the town to allow for additional commercial and residential development and open space development.
- Land annexed south of the Canadian Pacific Railway (CPR) will be easier and more economical to service that land north of the CPR.

A public meeting will be held on December 3, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers, Balgonie Administration Building to discuss the proposal.

PUBLIC NOTICE

Public Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 207 of <u>The Planning and Development Act,</u> 2007 that the Town of Balgonie intends to pass bylaws adopting an Official Community Plan, Bylaw No. 373 and new Zoning Bylaw, Bylaw No. 374.

Description

Both bylaws will affect all the property within the corporate limits of the Town.

The Official Community Plan contains a vision, mission and statement of objectives for the future development of the Town and contains policies to guide growth. The objectives and policies will address the future requirements for agricultural, resource, industrial, residential and commercial development. Policy on municipal services and environmental management and inter-municipal cooperation are also addressed.

The Zoning Bylaw is a regulatory document which implements the policies set forth in the Official Community Plan. The Zoning Bylaw will divide the Town into separate zoning districts based on existing and intended future land uses.

The Zoning Bylaw will contain regulations and standards that govern the size and subdivision of parcels, development standards for discretionary uses, and accessory uses. The Bylaw will be administered through a system of Development Permits and a comprehensive review procedure.

Any interested person may inspect the bylaws at the Town of Balgonie office between the hours of 9:00 A.M. - Noon and 1:00 P.M. - 5:00 P.M. on Monday to Friday (excluding statutory holidays). 

Cash donations are also gladly accepted. Please drop off at the Town office – Cheques made payable to the Balgonie Rec. Board – Dinner Theatre.


