



ELECTRONIC PAYMENTS:

Taxes and utility bills may be paid electronically through your online banking website. The payments would be under Town of Balgonie Taxes and Town of Balgonie Utilities.

(Do not choose Balgonie Water—this payee is a previous business and is not connected with the Town of Balgonie.)

Please contact the Town office to obtain your account numbers.

Electronic payments for utilities and taxes are a convenient way to pay your bills, but they are not instantaneous. Please allow 2-3 business days before any due date so that your payment is receipted by our office before any penalties apply. The bank requires time to process the payment and advise the Town.

The receipts for electronic payments will be available for pickup or mailed or emailed upon request.

TOWN COUNCIL MEETINGS are open to the public. They are regularly scheduled on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of every month starting at 6:15 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Balgonie Administration Building.

Council meetings in NOVEMBER are scheduled for NOVEMBER 10 and 24, 2014.

Reminder to Balgonie Residents:

Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 24 hours except weekends and holidays. If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park it on your own property. All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair. Storage of unlicensed and junked vehicles on your property are considered to be a "nuisance" by Town of Balgonie Bylaws.

SNOW REMOVAL:

As we are entering into the winter season, we need to be prepared for the SNOW which is likely to arrive. Our Town is fortunate to have great staff to clear our streets for us!! This time consuming job is made a lot easier when vehicles are moved off the streets for the graders to come through. As well, the Town Boulevard areas (the first 12-15 feet of each property) are where the snow is placed need to be free of vehicles and trailers.

The main streets are done first, followed by side streets and alleys are last. Depending on the severity of the storm and amount of snow, it may take a while for all streets to be cleared. We appreciate your patience and understanding. Thank you for treating our staff with respect.

Balgonie Town Council... What's on the Table?

Westview Park

Westview Park is still a high priority project. Council has initiated this project and is currently working toward engineered designs for the park. A big thank you to Plains Midstream Canada for their donation which has been reserved for the park. At this time, the land which is designated for the park is owned by the developer. When a servicing and development agreement is signed with the developer, the land will then be dedicated to the Town for a park space. At that point in time, the Town will have the ability to "break ground" on a park.

New Shop Space:

The Town of Balgonie has purchased the R.M. of Edenwold shop as they have moved into a new location. The added space will be very helpful for storage—we will then have the space to store all of the Town equipment indoors.

During our wind storm in August, damage did occur to this building. The R.M. is working with their insurance company to address the needed repairs prior to the Town's occupancy of the building.

Lagoon Discharge Update:

The Town of Balgonie is currently conducting an emergency discharge from the lagoon to pump out the polishing cell. This cell is the final stage of the sewage treatment system which is normally used for irrigation on hay crops. Due to the excessive rain at the end of June and beginning of July and the regular precipitation throughout the summer, irrigation could not be conducted to the extent it normally is. This left the Town's Lagoon with a high volume which needed to be addressed through discharge.

Discharge is monitored by the Water Security Agency and the Town has acquired a permit to do so. Application has been made to the Provincial Disaster Assistance Program to apply for funding the cost of this discharge.

Water & Sewer Bylaws:

Water and Sewer Rates and Water and Sewer Management bylaws are currently under review. The water transmission line from Pilot Butte is now complete and operational and the Town is purchasing water from Pilot Butte. Although the Town received a grant, Balgonie will be repaying on a debenture to cover its portion of the project. Town Council will be considering this expense, as well as, future lagoon expansion during this process.
