Do you know ...

**What the speed limit is of where  
you are driving?**

On Balgonie streets, the speed limit is 40Km/hr., unless you are in the school zone which is marked at 30Km/hr. The signs are located at the corners of Main St. & Assiniboia St. and Main St. & Qu'Appelle St.

Also, we have had a speed reduction on the Westview gravel road, between Highway 364 and Herauf St., the speed limit is 40Km/hr, after that to Highway 46 the speed limit is 80Km/hr.

Please be aware that the Highway #1 speed limit has been reduced to 80Km/hr for the construction of the bypass project.

As well as on Highway 46, there is a speed reduction around Pilot Butte from 100Km/hr to 80Km/hr.

**SNOW REMOVAL:**

As we are entering into the winter season, we need to be prepared for the SNOW which is likely to arrive. Our Town is fortunate to have great staff to clear our streets for us!! This time consuming job is made a lot easier when vehicles are moved off the streets for the graders to come through. As well, the Town Boulevard areas (the first 12-15 feet of each property) where the snow is placed, need to be free of vehicles and trailers.

The main streets are done first, followed by side streets and alleys are last. Depending on the severity of the storm and amount of snow, it may take a while for all streets to be cleared. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

**Please contact the Town office to obtain your account numbers.**

Electronic payments for utilities and taxes are a convenient way to pay your bills, but they are not instantaneous. Please allow 2-3 business days before any due date so that your payment is received by our office before any penalties apply. The bank requires time to process the payment and advise the Town.

**The receipts for electronic payments will be available for pickup, mailed or emailed upon request.**

### **Reminder to Balgonie Residents:**

**Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 24 hours except weekends and holidays. If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park it on your own property.**

**All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair. Storage of unlicensed and junked vehicles on your property are considered to be a “nuisance” by Town of Balgonie Bylaws.**

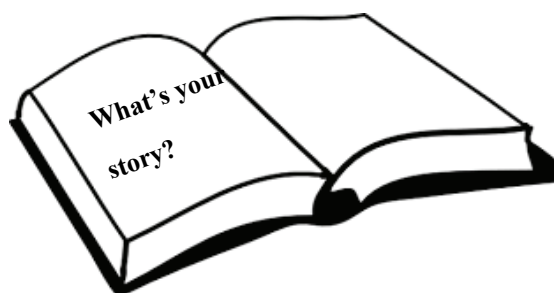
