CROSSWALK SAFETY

As a pedestrian:

- Make your intention to cross the road known by:
 - extending your arm,
 - illuminating an overhead light (it's the law in Canada),
 - or extending and waving a crosswalk flag
- Make eye contact with driver, never assume the drivers sees you.
- Wear bright coloured clothing during low-light and night conditions.



As a driver:

- Drivers must yield the right of way to pedestrians lawfully in or stopped facing a crosswalk.
- It doesn't matter whether the crosswalk is marked or unmarked—remember every intersection is a crosswalk, even if it's not marked.
- It is illegal to pass a vehicle that has stopped at a crosswalk to allow a pedestrian to cross.

REMEMBER: The school speed limit is 30km/hr, please slow down and watch for students.



TOWN OF BALGONIE – MAYOR THAUBERGER’S FIRE WEEK PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Town of Balgonie is committed to ensuring the safety and security of all those living in and visiting Balgonie; and

WHEREAS, fire is a serious public safety concern both locally and nationally, and homes are the locations where people are at greatest risk from fire; and

WHEREAS, home fires killed 2,755 people in the United States in 2013, according to the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA), and fire departments in the United States responded to 369,500 home fires; and

WHEREAS, working smoke alarms cut the risk of dying in reported home fires in half; and

WHEREAS, three out of five home fire deaths result from fires in properties without working smoke alarms; and

WHEREAS, in one-fifth of all homes with smoke alarms, none were working; and

WHEREAS, when smoke alarms should have operated but did not do so it was usually because batteries were missing, disconnected, or dead; and

WHEREAS, half of home fire deaths result from fires reported at night between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. when most people are asleep; and

WHEREAS, Balgonie’s residents should install smoke alarms in every sleeping room, outside each separate sleeping area, and on every level of the home; and

WHEREAS, Balgonie’s residents should install smoke alarms and alert devices that meet the needs of people who are deaf or hard of hearing; and

WHEREAS, Balgonie’s residents who have planned and practiced a home fire escape plan are more prepared and will therefore be more likely to survive a fire; and

WHEREAS, Balgonie’s first responders are dedicated to reducing the occurrence of home fires and home fire injuries through prevention and protection education; and

WHEREAS, Balgonie’s residents are responsive to public education measures and are able to take personal steps to increase their safety from fire, especially in their homes; and

WHEREAS, the 2015 Fire Prevention Week theme, “Hear the Beep Where You Sleep. Every Bedroom Needs a Working Smoke Alarm!” effectively serves to remind us that we need working smoke alarms to give us the time to get out safely.

THEREFORE, I, Frank Thauberger, Mayor of Balgonie do hereby proclaim October 4-10, 2015, as Fire Prevention Week throughout Balgonie, and I urge all the people of Balgonie to install smoke alarms in every bedroom, outside each sleeping area, and on every level of the home, including the basement and to support the many public safety activities and efforts of Balgonie’s fire and emergency services during Fire Prevention Week 2015.

Taxes and utility bills may be paid electronically through your online banking website. The payments would be under Town of Balgonie Taxes and Town of Balgonie Utilities.

(Do not choose Balgonie Water—this payee is a previous business and is not connected with the Town of Balgonie.)

Please contact the Town office to obtain your account numbers.

Electronic payments for utilities and taxes are a convenient way to pay your bills, but they are not instantaneous. Please allow 2-3 business days before any due date so that your payment is received by our office before any penalties apply. The bank requires time to process the payment and advise the Town.

The receipts for electronic payments will be available for pickup or mailed or emailed upon request.

Reminder to Balgonie Residents:

Vehicles are not to be parked on the street for more than 24 hours except weekends and holidays.

If your vehicle is not used regularly, you must park it on your own property. All vehicles stored on your property must be licensed and in good repair. Storage of unlicensed and junked vehicles on your property are considered to be a "nuisance" by Town of Balgonie Bylaws.

TOWN COUNCIL MEETINGS are open to the public. They are regularly scheduled on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of every month starting at 6:15 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Balgonie Administration Building.

Halloween Safety



Choose the right costume

- Use make up or face paint instead of masks, before you use the make up—do a test patch to make sure your is not allergic or sensitive to it.
- Improperly fitting masks can interfere with children's vision, if you choose a mask, make sure it fits properly and allows them to see properly
- Avoid costumes that are too big and have long dangling pieces that children can trip over.
- Nylon or heavyweight polyester costumes are best. Remember, that flame resistant does not mean fire proof.

Avoid Danger when decorating

- Check indoor and outdoor decorative lights for broken or cracked sockets, frayed or bare wires or loose connections. Do not overload extension cords.
- Instead of using candles, consider using a small flashlight or battery operated candles to light jack-o-lanterns.

Stay secure while trick or treating

- Give each child a flashlight to carry, to make themselves more visible to others.
- Make sure children look both ways and cross intersections when no cars are coming.
- Tell children to stay in well lit areas and only visit homes that have their outside lights turned on, make sure they know never to go inside homes or cars.

Be cautious with candy and toys

- Tell children not to eat any treats until you have looked them over.
- Be careful when giving children any treats that could be potential choking hazards such as chewy candies, peanuts and other hard candies.






